

**Metropolitan Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan
Update
Early Public Input Meetings**



The Fargo-Moorhead Metropolitan Council of Governments (Metro COG) will hold two early public input meetings on March 4 and March 9, 2010 for the update to the Metropolitan Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan. The March 4th Meeting will take place from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Dr. James Carlson Library, 2801 32 Ave South Fargo, North Dakota. The March 9th public input meeting will take place from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Main Fargo Library, 102 3rd St North, Fargo, North Dakota. The public input meetings will be conducted in an open house format.

The Metropolitan Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan is the Fargo-Moorhead region's bicycle and pedestrian master plan. The Plan will revise the short-range and long-range Federal Aid bicycle and pedestrian project lists. For bicycle and pedestrian projects to receive Federal Aid they must be in the Metropolitan Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan. Metro COG is seeking public input related to areas where there are bicycle and pedestrian safety concerns as well as bicycle and pedestrian network connectivity issues.
